The Cypress Bay High School "Sound of Thunder" Band Program

Over the years, the Cypress Bay Band Program has been extraordinarily successful. Performing ensembles have been invited to highly recognized state and national events! The Marching Band has received high scores at FBA (district assessment) and FMBC (regional) competitions. And highly skilled musicians have hosted onsite clinics that raised the level of our students' performance.

Mr. Dawson, Band Director, took responsibility for the Cypress Bay High School band program in the summer of 2020 (<https://ourcitymedia.com/2020/09/22/cypress-bay-welcomes-new-band-director/>). His experience as a professional jazz trombonist and 20 years as the former Director of Bands at Coral Springs High School helped him keep students engaged despite the challenges of teaching in a virtual environment during the 2020-21 school year. Last year, he has led his students to earn the very special Otto J. Kraushaar Award, given to those band programs in the state that have earned straight superior ratings at all Florida Band Association events during a single school year, including marching, district concert, and state concert competitions!!!

2023-24 Band Programs

- Curriculum Electives Classes
 - Three-levels of Concert Band Classes: Concert Band, Symphonic Band and Wind Ensemble
 - Jazz Band 1-2-3-4 (taken in addition to a Concert Ensemble)
 - Music Theory: Honors and AP (the Honors class is a pre-requisite for AP)
 - Eurythmics (Color & Winter Guard) 1-2-3-4
- After School Programs
 - Marching Band to include winds, percussion, and color guard (June to November)
 - Indoor Percussion season (December to March) – To be confirmed in September
 - Winter Guard season (December to March) – To be confirmed in September

Students may elect the option to take Band with Honors Credit as soon as Freshman year. Requirements include:

- A few extra assignments per quarter (performance critique, biography research, ...)
- Auditioning for All State and All County Bands
- Perform at the FBA Solo & Ensemble Festival

Concert and Jazz Bands

- Until November (end of Marching Season), concert and jazz band classes are usually limited to school hours. After school rehearsals and clinics will start after Thanksgiving to prepare the Holiday Concert and competitive performances such as Jazz, Solo & Ensemble, and Concert MPAs that begin in February.
- Students also work with guest clinicians and conductors.
- The Fair Share for a band elective is \$125-250 per year (waived if participating in Marching Band). This fee provides for band room supplies, music scores, clinicians, competition registration and local performances.

- Fair Share does not include:
 - Instrument rental (most of the larger instruments are available for a low annual rental fee)
 - Concert attire is usually not included in the annual fees.
 - An annual fieldtrip fee may be added later in the year, depending on the destination.

Cypress Bay High School's Music Department also includes a large Chorus program, Guitar and Keyboard classes, as well as a Music Tech & Sound Engineering elective. The Department Head, Mr. Franks is happy to answer any questions regarding these electives. Mr. Franks also sponsors the "Tri-M Music Honor Society" chapter at Cypress Bay. This club welcomes all musicians and singers who want to make a difference in music education, get involved in community service activities and be a proud representative of the music program at The Bay! Marching Band

The Marching Band is comprised of winds, percussion and color guard performers. All members of the Marching Band are expected to participate in the annual rehearsal/performance as follows:

- Normally, Marching activities begin with a one-week June camp at the end of the school year. All returning and new Marching Band students are invited to work on marching and performance skills.
- Season registration usually takes place that same week in June.
- There is usually a rehearsal one day a week throughout the summer for Marching Band members.
- A two-week intensive camp before school starts
- After school starts again in August, there are usually 2/3 afternoon rehearsals a week, plus Friday football games.
- Competitions (usually 5, always on Saturdays) begin in October and run through mid-November.
- Marching Band is a high intensity activity with certain physical and mental demands. Students develop mental fortitude, physical endurance, teamwork and support, friendship and respect that will benefit them throughout their lives!
- Marching Band students earn 100 volunteer service hours per season.

Summer Jazz Camp

This camp is offered to middle and high school students during the summer. It covers the basics of jazz performance for beginners and offers additional growth to more experienced musicians. The camp is taught by band directors, clinicians, and the most advanced high school musicians.

A FEW ESSENTIALS for the 2023-24 Band Season!

BoosterHub App is our **new Communication HUB** for all band programs including Marching Band, Guard, Concert Band, Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble, Percussion and Jazz Band classes. It includes the band calendar (you can sync it with your personal calendar), the student forms, the band store, volunteer opportunities and credit card payment options for program fees. And we use it for announcements, emails, and chats.

Both parents and students get a personal access to the platform and have to agree with its Terms of Use. It is essential that **everyone keeps their contact information up to date** for the Band Director and the CBBPA Board to promptly send important information and updates regarding the program.

TIP! Select the type of notifications you prefer so it becomes a friendly and efficient way for you to keep in touch!

Apparel

- Marching Students (music and guard) will get special outfits depending on the season's theme. They will be asked to purchase a few items like shoes, water jugs, etc.
- All Concert Band, Jazz and Percussion Musicians usually wear a **Black Outfit with Black Shoes** (no open toes). The Band Director will confirm if additional items need to be purchased.
- Guard members will get special instructions from their Guard Director for both Marching and Winter seasons.

Music Instruments

- Percussion and big size instruments are generally available for rental at the school. A rental contract must be signed before any instrument can be taken home or to the marching band field. The rental fee is minimal (\$10-30) and should be paid on the Cypress Bay OSP website - <https://osp.osmsinc.com/browardfl/> (NOT CBBPA).
- Students are held responsible for the good care of the rented instrument(s) and should inform the Band Director of any issue happening to their instrument(s). They should ask the Band Director before deciding on any repair.
- Repairs are funded by the School District but at a very low level; any donation is always welcome to help with the cost of instrument maintenance and repairs.
- For smaller instruments, students can use their personal one or get a rental with local music stores (like All County music store). They should address any financial challenge with the Band Director.

Forms

- Parents/Guardians are required to fill out and sign a yearly fieldtrip form
- For certain fieldtrips, a transportation release might be required for parent drop-off or pick-up in case no transportation is provided by the program or for special occasions.
- These forms are usually available on the Boosterhub app files section.

FairShare

- The Marching Season Fair Share usually includes -but is not limited to- funding for special instructors' compensation, music purchase & arrangements, show accessories & props, competition registration, transportation, lodging, and annual operating expenses for the program (tax filing, accounting services, etc.).
- The Winterguard season FairShare follows the same principles. This season is also open to wind and percussion students.

A FEW ESSENTIALS for the 2023-24 Band Season! (page2)

- The Concert Season FairShare is for Band students not registered in the Marching Season. It includes -but is not limited to- funding for instructors' compensation (masterclasses), music purchase, competition registration and transportation, and annual operating expenses for the program (tax filing, accounting services, etc.).
- The FairShare amounts are voted each year, based upon the season planned by the Band Director.
- Band Fair Shares may be tax-deductible and a payment plan is usually offered over several months.
- Students with financial challenges may discuss solutions with the Band Director and CBBPA will work on extra fundraising options to make sure no student will be left out for financial reasons.

Volunteering with CBBPA: WE REALLY NEED YOU! Many hands make small work!

The **band parents' involvement is crucial** to the success of the program. CBBPA also has an important role in making the program as affordable as possible through **active fundraising** to make sure no student is left out for financial reasons.

The program has **many volunteer opportunities** throughout the school year. It is expected that all parents volunteer at least **5 hours** of their time during the school year. Some opportunities include serving meals, chaperoning, taking charge of competitions props, selling concessions, fundraising, and participating on the Board of the CBBPA. Volunteering opportunities are usually posted in the **Charms calendar** wherever there is a little **"multicolored hand"**. If you click on the hand, you can sign up to volunteer for a specific event. Chat groups are also a way to request and coordinate help.

CBBPA Board members include:

- 5 "Executives": President, VP, Fundraising Director, Treasurer and Secretary
- 2 to 6 "Directors" who can help in various areas like volunteer coordination, communication, admin support, uniforms & logo items, marching logistics, fundraising, band liaisons.

After July 1st, all volunteers need to get/renew their level 1 clearance online at <https://www.browardschools.com/page/32043> . **We also need level 2 volunteers**, which requires fingerprinting and is valid for 5 years. The process is handled by one of the board members and the school volunteer coordinator.



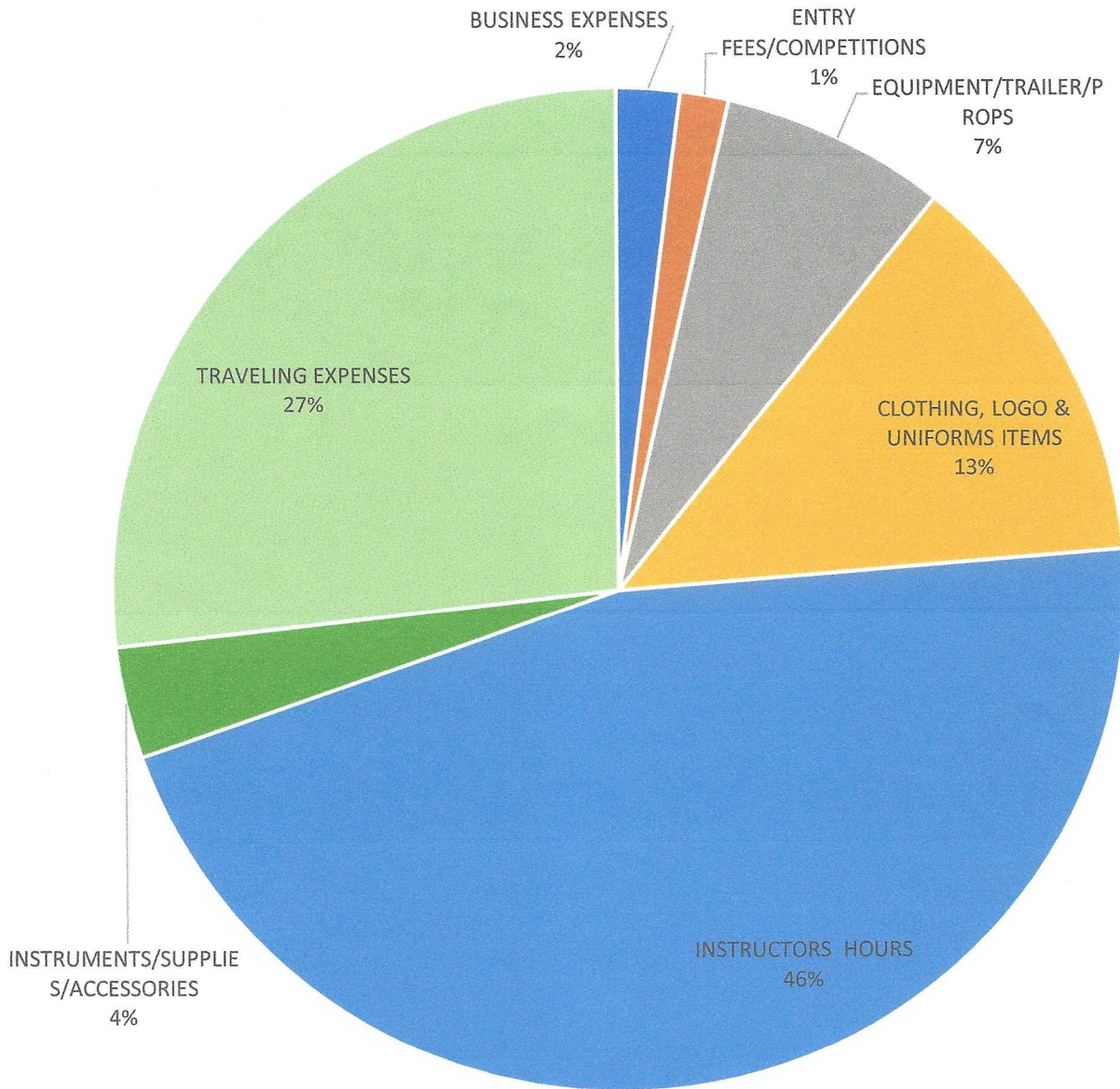

Any student who pays this marching band Fair Share will NOT have to pay the Concert Season Fairshare for the 2023-24 school year, as a portion of it will be allocated to this other budget.
